## **Groundnut Outlook – April 2024**

Groundnut is an important oilseed crop in India which occupies first position in terms of area and second position in terms of production after soyabean. China ranks first in groundnut production with 18.38 million tonnes followed by India 10.13 million tonnes, Nigeria 4.28 lakh tonnes, United States of America 2.53 million tonnes and Sudan 2.50 million tonnes accounting for 34, 19, 8, 5 and 5 percent of total world production of 54.29 million tonnes in 2022.

According to the second advance estimates 2023-24, Government of India groundnut (kharif and rabi) crop is estimated at 86.54 lakh tonnes as compared to 102.87 lakh tonnes in 2022-23. Among the states, Gujarat is leading in groundnut production with 36.74 lakh tonnes followed by Rajasthan (20.86 lakh tonnes), Madhya Pradesh (9.09 lakh tonnes), Tamil Nadu (7 lakh tonnes), Karnataka (3.69 lakh tonnes) and Telangana (1.98 lakh tonnes).

According to the all India rabi crop coverage report, Government of India, as on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2024, groundnut was sown in around 4.88 lakh hectares as compared to last year (5.68 lakh ha). Among the states, Karnataka stood first in area coverage with 1.11 lakh ha followed by Odisha (1.00 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.96 lakh ha), Telangana (0.84 lakh ha) and Andhra Pradesh (0.72 lakh ha).

In Telangana, groundnut has been sown in around 2,09,945 acres as on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2024. Among the districts, Nagarkurnool stood first in groundnut sown area with 1,04,513 acres followed by Wanaparthy (21,286 acres), Nalgonda (18,289 acres), Vikarabad (13,444 acres) and Mahabubnagar (11,035 acres). MSP for groundnut has been increased by Rs. 527 to Rs. 6377 per quintal for marketing season 2023-24 from Rs.5850 per quintal in 2022-23.

## **Groundnut Price Outlook**

Rajkot groundnut bold prices rebounded after three consecutive weeks declined and went up by 1.2% at INR 5,986/Qtl amid improved demand from crushers. Over the past month, prices have declined by 3%, over the last three months down by 4%.

As per trade sources, cumulative groundnut exports from October 2023 to February 2024 have decreased by 20%, totaling 3.08 lakh tonnes compared to 3.85 lakh tonnes during the same period last year.

However, groundnut exports surged in February 2024, rising by 42% to 0.77 lakh tonnes compared to 0.54 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period last year. Indonesia (33%) and Vietnam (12%) remained the top importers. The decline in exports is putting pressure on domestic prices.

Moreover, cumulative groundnut oil exports from October 2023 to February 2024 have plummeted by 48%, amounting to 0.37 lakh tonnes compared to 0.72 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period last year.

In February 2024, groundnut oil exports saw a significant decline of 96% to 670 tonnes compared to 17,826 tonnes in the corresponding period last year. China (32%) and Singapore (23%) remained the top importers in January 2024. Overall, cumulative exports of both groundnut seed and groundnut oil have decreased, contributing to the downward pressure on domestic prices.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that groundnut may trade in a range of **Rs.** 6650–7050 per quintal during the month of April 2024.
