SPOT (MOP-UP) Combined counselling for admission into Bi.P.C. Stream Courses of PJTSAU and SKLTSHU for the Academic Year 2023-24

The SPOT (MOP-UP) combined counseling for the candidates who have submitted their ONLINE application for admission into Bi.P.C. Stream Courses of Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University (PJTSAU), Hyderabad and Sri Konda Laxman Telangana State Horticultural University (SKLTSHU), Mulugu for the Academic Year 2023-24 *viz.*, B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture / B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science / B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture based on their Telangana EAMCET-2023 ranks will be held at the University Auditorium, PJTSAU Campus, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad as per the schedule mentioned below:

Note:

- 1. Vacancies if any arise, even on the date of the counselling also will be considered for admission process.
- 2. As this is a Mop Up (Spot counselling), if candidates of one particular social category are not available for admission, such seats will be shifted to another social category as per the rule of reservation. Hence, all the applicants of all categories (OC, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E, SC & ST BOTH Non-Rural, Non-Rural, FARMERS & FARMERS) may attend the counselling.

The vacant seat position shall be posted on the University website on 27-12-2023 by 4:00 PM.

- 1. The Government of Telangana has sanctioned two new Under Graduate Colleges for the AY 2023-24:
 - i. Agricultural College at Tornala, Siddipet district offering B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture
 - ii. College of Horticulture at Malyal, Mahabubabad district offering B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture
 - * The seats pertaining to these two new colleges were included during the 2nd phase of counselling.
 - * In view of the establishment of these new colleges, the applicants who are desirous to take admission can opt these colleges and the applicants who already secured admission in the previous counsellings can also opt for sliding to these new colleges during this counselling.
- 2. Fee should be paid immediately after securing admission in **CASH** mode only. No ONLINE/UPI transactions are accepted.

Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from families of Agriculturist cum Rural Area (Farmers' Quota) in B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture courses:

- Forty per cent (40%) of the seats in the PJTSAU & SKLTSHU are reserved for candidates coming from families of Agriculturists (Farmers) owning not less than ONE acre of land either in the name of the parents or in the name of the candidate and who have studied for a minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate.
- > If the land is owned by grandfather, grandmother or guardian or any other relations is not acceptable under farmer quota.
- ANNEXURE-I: It is a proforma to be certified by the Head Master of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate (Non-Municipal Area Certificate).
- ANNEXURE-II: It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate / parents duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal (or) the candidate has to upload attested photocopies of pattadar pass book as evidence of the extent of agricultural land.
- ➤ ANNEXURE-I and ANNEXURE-II need to be filled in with the signatures of concerned officials viz., concerned Head of Institution and Tahsildar, respectively, along with office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from Rural Area (Rural Quota) in B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science course:

• Forty per cent (40%) of the seats are reserved for candidates who have studied for a minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas.

- ANNEXURE -I: It is a proforma to be certified by the Head Master of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate (Non-Municipal Area Certificate) (ANNEXURE I).
- ANNEXURE -I need to be filled in with the signatures of concerned officials viz., concerned Head of Institution respectively, along with office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of counselling:

- a) Online Application Form.
- b) SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.
- c) Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination).
- d) Telangana State EAMCET-2023 Rank Card.
- e) Bonafide / Study Certificate from 6th to 12th Class.
- f) Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I) (At least four years of the study period before the qualifying examination), if applicable.
- g) Latest Agricultural Land Holding Certificate (ANNEXURE-II) (at least 1 acre agricultural land) or Original **pattadar pass book,** if applicable.
- h) The certified copy of the Social Status (Caste) Certificate issued by the competent authority from Telangana State in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- i) The certified copy of the EWS Certificate issued for the year 2023-24 by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to EWS.
- j) If the candidate has joined in any of the college of PJTSAU & SKLTSHU during the previous phases of allotment he/she has to submit the following documents:
 - i. Copy of Admission letter.
 - ii. Custodian certificate of the institute joined.
 - iii. Fee receipt of the respective college.

Fee:

The fee particulars of U.G. Programmes of three Universities are as follows:

Note: Fee should be paid immediately after securing admission in **CASH** mode only. No ONLINE / UPI transactions are accepted.

- > The **hostel and mess** charges are additional/extra.
- ➤ Hostel accommodation will be provided subject to availability.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS: -

- Vacancies if any arise, even on the date of the counselling also will be considered for admission process. Candidates are required to read the prospectus thoroughly before attending the counselling.
- During the sliding process opted by the candidates from one college to another college or one course and another course a few seats may arise in the categories which are not mentioned in the seat availability position.
- The candidates who secured admission in the previous phase are also eligible for subsequent phases of counselling for better course or better college preferred by him/her.
- The following candidates are eligible for the counselling:
 - Who secured a seat in earlier phase of counseling and wish to move to some other colleges as per their merit and rule of reservation
 - Candidates who participated in earlier phase of counseling and could not secure a seat.
 - Candidates who did not participate in the earlier phase.
 - Candidates who were allotted a seat but didn't report/pay the fee at the college.
 - A candidate allotted a seat in earlier phase but cancelled his/her admission.
- > The candidates are advised to verify the certificates whether they belong to farmers quota or not. Annexure-I (Non-Municipal Area Certificate) and Annexure-II (Agricultural Land Holding Certificate) both are mandatory to claim seat under FARMERS' quota.
- > The candidates are advised to verify the certificates whether they belong to RURAL quota or not. Annexure-I (Non-Municipal Area Certificate) is mandatory to claim seat under RURAL quota.
- > Both should have been taken in the current year 2023-24.
- Candidates are required to read the prospectus thoroughly before attending the counselling.
- ➤ All the candidates should read prospectus thoroughly till you understand it.
- > The parents and candidates should visit the University website www.pjtsau.edu.in regularly during the counselling dates for updates and the availability of seats under various categories.
- > All the candidates are informed to visit the website (www.pjtsau.edu.in) for seat availability position before attending the counselling, which will be updated regularly during the counselling days.
- > For the Un-Reserved (Non-Local 15%) quota, any candidate from Telangana / Andhra Pradesh / Un-Reserved with TS EAMCET-2023 Rank can compete on the basis of merit and rule of reservation.

- This notification shall be treated as an individual intimation and no separate intimation will be issued
- > All Categories means the candidate belonging to OC, EWS, BC, SC and ST including Non-Rural, Rural, Non-Farmer and Farmer.
- > The candidates need to attend the counselling on the scheduled day as per the ranks indicated.
- > The candidates are required to produce all the relevant original certificates at the time of counselling failing which the candidature for admission will be rejected.
- > The selected candidates will have to pay the requisite fees inclusive of deposits (in cash) immediately failing which the seat will stand cancelled.
- ➤ If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat before the closure of admissions for the Academic Year 2023-24 an amount of Rs. 1,000/- shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- After closure of admissions process for the AY 2023-24 the candidate forfeits the fees already paid and in addition he/she has to pay cancellation fees as per the norms of the respective Universities (indicated in the fees structure).
- > Selection of candidates under EWS, BC, SC & ST quota is subject to clearance of the respective social status by the respective Directorates of Government of Telangana.
- > The guidelines issued by Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously.
- > Counselling is held manually, not online counselling.
- > The Universities do not guarantee any employment to the candidates joining the courses.
- The counseling process is likely to extend late into the evening; hence the candidates and parents/guardians are requested to come well prepared for the same.
- More number of candidates than the availability of seats are called for counseling and hence, mere attendance / participation during counselling does not guarantee admission.
- > Candidates should report at the counselling center one hour before the scheduled time.
- > Certificates / documents other than those uploaded will not be entertained or considered for the allotment of seats.
- ➤ Candidates belonging to EWS, BC, SC & ST categories should bring two Xerox copies of their relevant certificate to be submitted at the counselling center.
- > The seats reserved under EWS/BC/SC/ST categories including farmers quota shall also be filled up simultaneously during the counseling process on the scheduled days.
- > Sliding and shifting from one course to another course and one college to another college will be done based on the merit and rule of reservation and availability of seats.
- > In the event of sliding from one course to another course and one college to another college the candidates need to pay the differential amounts of fees as per the fee structure of the respective Universities.
- In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University will take appropriate legal action against the individuals concerned.
- > The University is not responsible for any information provided in websites other than at www.pjtsau.edu.in.
- Parents and Students are informed that the admissions are purely based on merit and guidelines of the University and as such they are requested not to rely on any middlemen/persons/consultants who try to mislead the students in securing admission into PJTSAU under any quota. All the seats will be filled by the University only through combined counselling.
- > The candidates may take original certificates on request by furnishing an undertaking, if they have any other counsellings to be attended and return the certificates after the stipulated day. If they fail to return the certificates to the college, the admission shall stand cancelled. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- The selected candidates are advised to take mobile numbers of the concerned officers of the allotted college for official information.
- > Candidates are informed to attend counselling on the scheduled date and time. If they fail to attend they cannot claim the seat as per merit.
- > Candidates, if attend the counselling late, they will have to submit the letter to the counselling authorities duly indicating the time of their attending the counselling.
