• COED: means Co-Education.

Eligibility:

- i) Passed in SSC or its equivalent education or
- ii) TS-POLYCET 2023 (Agriculture stream) or
- iii) TS-POLYCET 2023 (Engineering stream)

Criteria for selection (Priority):

- Priority 1: The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the **basis of ranks obtained by the candidates under Agriculture Stream** in the Telangana
 State **TS-POLYCET-2023** conducted by SBTET.
- Priority 2: The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the **basis of ranks obtained by the candidates under Engineering Stream** in the
 Telangana State **TS-POLYCET-2023** conducted by SBTET
- Priority 3: The OGPA obtained in SSC or its equivalent examination for applicants without TS-POLYCET-2023 ranks
 - ➤ In case of tie the grade point obtained in first Science and later Maths, English, Telugu, Social and Hindi will be taken into consideration.
 - ➤ If tie continues, the age of the candidates shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference for the seat.
- **❖** Candidates who have already applied need not apply again and may attend the counselling.

Age:

Candidates for admission into these courses in the University shall be required to have completed 15 years of age as on the year of admission (as on 31-12-2023) with an upper age limit of 22 years.

Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from Rural Area:

- > Sixty per cent (60%) of the seats in various diploma courses of PJTSAU are reserved for candidates who have studied for a minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas.
- ➤ <u>ANNEXURE-I (Non-Municipal Area Certificate)</u>: It is a proforma to be certified by the Headmaster of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 10th class.
- > If ANNEXURE-I is not filled in or duly signed by the concerned Head of Institution or officer along with office seal, the claim of the candidates will be rejected under Rural Area category.

Residential Certificate:

➤ Applicants who have gap/break in the years of study for reasons other than failure or any discontinuation those who passed the qualifying examination by private study have to submit this certificate issued by the Tahsildar. In case, the applicant has resided in more than one place, a separate certificate from the Tahsildar should be furnished for such places of residence.

Reservation of Seats:

The rule of reservation (OC:50%, BC-A:7%, BC-B;10%, BC-C:1%, BC-D:7%, BC-E:4%, SC:15%, ST:6%, EWS:10%) will be followed as per the rules. The rule of reservation will be followed as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time.

Reservation of Special category seats:

The counselling for the Physically Challenged (PH@3%), Children of Armed Personnel (CAP@2%), National Cadet Corps (NCC@1%) & SPORTS (@0.5%) quota seats shall be conducted in presence of the Officers of the departments concerned. The certificates of the candidates of above special categories shall be verified by the officers and the seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by them.

Screening Tests for the Physically Challenged candidates:

Among the seats available for admission into various Diploma courses of the University, 3% are reserved for the Physically Handicapped/Challenged candidates.

The candidate seeking the benefit of the reservation under Physically Challenged quota should present himself/herself before a Selection Committee comprising of Residential Medical Officer, Specialists in the concerned fields of medicine and Deans of Faculty, which shall examine the suitability of the candidates to the course based on their degree of disability which shall be based on their performance in the screening tests and the decision of the committee shall be final for the purpose of admission.

The candidates seeking admission into various Diploma courses of PJTSAU will be required to perform the activities as part of the selection process such as **Identification of slides through Microscopes**, **Operation of push/wheel hoes and walking on the bunds**, **spraying with knapsack/power sprayer**, **Weeding & digging**, **Irrigating the fields as the case may be**.

Allocation of seats in favour of Local candidates in relation to Local area:

85% of the seats are reserved for local candidates and 15% of seats are Un-Reserved. **Hostel facility:**

Hostel accommodation for the candidates shall be provided subject to the availability.

Fees:

- 1. Payment of application fee for SC/ST/PH candidates is Rs.600/- (for all other candidates Rs.1200/-). The applicant has to select the Rupay Debit Card/UPI/Debit Card /Credit Card (Visa / MasterCard)/Internet Banking option to pay the fee and follow the online instruction to complete the payment of the fee.
- 2. Selected candidate for admission into **University polytechnics** shall pay an amount of **Rs. 19,945**/- in cash **immediately** during admission for First Semester (Hostel and Mess charges are additional).
- 3. Selected candidate for admission into **Affiliated polytechnics** shall pay an amount of **Rs. 22,210/-** in cash **immediately** during admission for First Semester (Hostel and Mess charges are additional).
- 4. If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat <u>before the closure of admissions</u> for the AY 2023-24 an amount of Rs. 1,000/- shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- 5. If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat <u>after the closure of admissions</u> process for the AY 2023-24 the candidate forfeits the fees already paid and in addition, he/she has to pay processing of Rs. 1,000/-.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of Counselling/Admission:

- 1. SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate.
- 2. TS-POLYCET-2023 Rank Card.
- 3. Bonafide / Study Certificate from 4th to 10th Class.
- 4. Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I) if applicable.
- 5. The latest certified copy of the Social Status (Caste) Certificate issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- 6. The latest certified copy of the EWS Certificate valid for the year 2023-24 issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to EWS category.
- 7. Physically Challenged Certificate.
- 8. Children of Armed Personnel Certificate / Defence Personnel Certificate.
- 9. National Cadet Corps (NCC) certificate.
- 10. Sports and Games Certificates (Form-I/Form-II/Form-III/Form-IV as applicable).

NOTE:

- > The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously including the reservations for EWS.
- > The University does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.
- ➤ The selected candidates for admission into Diploma courses of PJTSAU shall pay the prescribed fees immediately. The detailed fee structure shall be placed in the University website www.pjtsau.edu.in along with the admission notification.
- ➤ If the candidate cancels his/her seat *before the closure of admissions* for the Academic Year 2023-24 the entire fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- ➤ If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat *after the closure of admissions* process for the AY 2023-24 the candidate forfeits the fees already paid except caution deposits and in addition, he/she has to pay processing fee of Rs.1,000/-.
- ➤ It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to ensure that he/she fulfils the specified eligibility criteria before submitting the online application.
- ➤ The applicant has to first pay the application registration fee. A Payment reference number will be generated for all successful online payments.
- ➤ After the successful payment, the applicant has to fill in all the details of the application and upload the required documents.
- ➤ On successful completion of payment and submission of online application form the Application Number will be generated and this can be used for future reference.
- > The procedure of submission of completion is not complete with mere payment of fees but the application shall be submitted.
- > Candidates are informed that mere submission of an online application and attending for counselling does not guarantee the allotment of seat.
- > Candidates called for counselling will have to attend at their own cost only. One of the Parents / Guardian of the candidate shall be allowed for counselling.
- > The candidate who secures a seat, should submit the certificates in Original along with the prescribed fees at the time of counselling itself.

- > Only 15% of total intake (of that corresponding academic year) of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture and B.Tech.(Agricultural Engineering) are reserved for the passed out Diploma holders for an entry into the First year of concerned UG courses through AGRICET, [B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture] and AGRIENGGCET [B.Tech.(Agricultural Engineering)], entrance examinations conducted by the University.
- > The certificates of the candidates under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC & SPORTS) shall be verified by the authorities concerned. The University will not interfere in the process of preparation of priority/merit lists. The University allots seats to the candidates based on the priorities indicated by the competent authorities.
- ➤ The Counselling/Verification under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC & SPORTS) will be held in the presence of authorities concerned and seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by the officers concerned.
- ➤ In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University **will take appropriate action** against the individuals concerned and his/her application will be summarily rejected.
- The candidate should visit the University website (www.pjtsau.edu.in) frequently for updated and latest admission information.
- > Candidates are required to read the PROSPECTUS thoroughly before applying.
- ➤ The counselling shall be conducted on 09-08-2023 at 9:30 am at University Auditorium, PJTSAU, Rajendranagar. No separate intimation shall be done to the applicants in this regard.
