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Inview of increased demand and interest expressed by the candidates as seen during the first phase of combined counselling and in order to promote agricultural education to all, the Universities PJTAU and SKLTGHU have reduced the fee under Self Financing quota (from now referred as **SPECIAL quota**) from Rs. 10 lakhs to Rs. 5 lakhs and from Rs. 9 lakhs to Rs. 5 lakhs respectively and further increased the intake as detailed below:

- The candidates who have earlier applied under regular quota for Combined Counselling are all eligible for this Special quota notification also, they need not apply again.**

**Eligibility:**

- A pass in two-year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana State or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University or Intermediate Board with the following subjects namely:
  - Physical Sciences
  - Biological Sciences

### Criteria for selection:

- The selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the **Telangana EAPCET-2024** conducted by the **Telangana Council for Higher Education**.
- In case of a tie in ranks obtained by two or more candidates in the Telangana EAPCET-2024, the marks secured in the optional subjects of the qualifying examination (Intermediate or its equivalent) shall be taken into consideration. In case of a further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidate shall be given preference.

### Age:

- The candidates for admission into B.Sc.(Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc.(Hons.) Community Science, B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc.(Hons.) Horticulture courses shall be required to have completed 17 years of age with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates, 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates; and 27 years for Physically Challenged candidates as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission.

### Fee structure:

The revised fee particulars in respect of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science, B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture under SPECIAL Quota for AY 2024-25 admitted batch is as follows:

- ❖ The candidates seeking admission under SPECIAL QUOTA (earlier Self-Financing quota) for B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture / B. Sc. (Hons.) Community Science / B.Tech. (Food Technology)/ B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture should bring **DD (Demand Draft)** in favour of **“Comptroller, PJTAU”** payable at Hyderabad for an amount of **Rs. 39,100/-** (Rupees thirty nine thousand one hundred only) and pay **Rs. 23,400/-** (Rupees twenty three thousand four hundred only) **in cash** (detailed fee structure at Annexure I & II).

### Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from families of Agriculturist cum Rural Area (Farmers' Quota) in B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture, B.Tech. (Food Technology) courses:

- **Forty percent (40%)** of the seats in the PJTAU & SKLTGHU are reserved for candidates coming from families of Agriculturists (Farmers) owning **not less than ONE acre of land either in the name of the parents or in the name of the candidate** and who have studied for a **minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas** during their period of study from 1<sup>st</sup> class to 12<sup>th</sup> class / Intermediate.
- If the land is owned by **grand father, grand mother or guardian or any other relations is not acceptable under farmer quota.**
- **ANNEXURE-I:** It is a proforma to be certified by **the Head Master** of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a **minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas** during their period of study from 1<sup>st</sup> class to 12<sup>th</sup> class/Intermediate (**Non-Municipal Area Certificate**).

- **ANNEXURE-II:** It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate / parents duly certified by the **Tahsildar with his office seal (or)** the candidate has to furnish ORIGINAL **pattadar pass book** as evidence of the extent of agricultural land.
- **ANNEXURE-I and ANNEXURE-II** need to be filled in with the **signatures of concerned officials viz., concerned Head of Institution and Tahsildar, respectively**, along with office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

### **Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from Rural Area (Rural Quota) in B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science course:**

- **Forty per cent (40%) of the seats** are reserved for candidates who have studied for a **minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas.**
- **ANNEXURE-I:** It is a proforma to be certified by the **Head Master** of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a **minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas** during their period of study from 1<sup>st</sup> class to 12<sup>th</sup> class / Intermediate (**Non-Municipal Area Certificate**) (**ANNEXURE – I**).
- **ANNEXURE-I** need to be filled in with the **signatures of concerned officials viz., concerned Head of Institution respectively**, along with office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

### **Residential Certificate:**

- Applicants who have gap/break in the years of study for reasons other than failure or those who passed the qualifying examination by private study have to submit this certificate issued by the Tahsildar. In case, the applicant has resided in more than one place, separate certificate from the Tahsildar, should be furnished for such places of residence.

### **Reservation of Seats:**

The rule of reservation (OC:46%, EWS;10%, BC-A:7%, BC-B;10%, BC-C:1%, BC-D:7%, BC-E:4%, SC:15%, ST:10%) will be followed as per the rules.

### **Reservation of Special category seats:**

Reservation under **Physically Challenged (PH@5%\*)**, **Children of Armed Personnel (CAP@2%)**, **National Cadet Corps (NCC@1%)** & **SPORTS (@0.5%)** categories shall also be followed. The certificates of the candidates of above special categories shall be verified by the officers and the seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by them. The University has no interference in indicating priorities.

**\* Note: The implementation of 5% reservation for Physically Challenged /Handicapped quota is subject to further orders / guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana, otherwise the earlier 3% reservation under this quota shall be implemented.**

### **Reservation of seats for Women:**

- In each course,  $33\frac{1}{3}\%$  of the seats shall be horizontally reserved in favour of women candidates from each category.

### **Allocation of seats:**

- Out of total, 85% of the seats are reserved for local candidates and 15% of seats are Un-Reserved.

**Note: The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously including the reservations for 15% of seats under Un-Reserved quota.**

### **Hostel facility:**

- **Hostel facility shall be provided subject to the availability of accommodation in the respective colleges.**

### **Original certificates to be produced at the time of counselling:**

- SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.
- Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination).
- Telangana EAPCET-2024 Rank Card.
- Bonafide / Study Certificate from 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Class.

- Transfer Certificate of the institute last studied.
- The certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana State in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- The latest certified copy of the EWS Certificate valid for the year 2024-25 issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to EWS category.
- Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I), if applicable.
- Agricultural Land Holding Certificate (ANNEXURE-II), if applicable
- The certified copy Physically Challenged Certificate, if applicable.
- Children of Armed Personnel Certificate / Defence Personnel Certificate, if applicable.
- National Cadet Corps (NCC) Certificate, if applicable.
- Sports and Games Certificates along with Form I, II, III & IV (whichever is applicable) which are mandatory for claiming seat under SPORTS quota, if applicable.

**Note:**

- The rules and regulations with regard to eligibility, age, reservations etc., are the same for the SPECIAL quota that are applicable to the candidates admitted under general quota.
- The candidates selected under SPECIAL quota will be treated on par with regular students. No specific amenities or facilities will be provided.
- **In addition to the fee mentioned above, refundable deposits pertaining to Laboratory (@ Rs 2500), Library (@ Rs 2500) by all the boarders and non-boarders and Mess deposit (@ Rs 5500), Hostel deposit (@ Rs 5500), Hostel Room rent (@ Rs 1650 per semester) and Hostel establishment charges (@ Rs 5500 per semester) by the boarders have to be paid with respect to the candidates who get admitted in PJTAU.**
- **In addition to the fee mentioned above, refundable deposits pertaining to Laboratory (@ Rs 2000), Library (@ Rs 2000) by all the boarders and non-boarders and Mess deposit (@ Rs 5000), Hostel deposit (@ Rs 5000), Hostel Room rent (@ Rs 1760 per semester) and Hostel establishment charges (@ Rs 6600 per semester) by the boarders have to be paid with respect to the candidates who get admitted in SKLTGHU.**
- The unfilled seats under SPECIAL quota will not be filled up from any other stream and will be kept vacant.
- **The candidates admitted under this quota are not eligible for any reimbursement of fee or educational concessions offered by the Government.**
- **The University will send SMS to the applicants for the purposes related to admissions. Hence the candidates are informed to mention their personal mobile numbers but not the mobile numbers of relatives, friends, net/online/Xerox centres etc.**
- **In the event of establishment of new colleges such seats will also be considered for filling up through this notification only.**
- The Counselling/Verification under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC & SPORTS) will be held in the presence of authorities concerned and seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by the officers concerned.
- **If the admitted candidate cancels/withdraws his/her seat before the closure of admission process, the entire fee collected from the student shall be refunded in full after deducting Rs. 5000/- for as processing fee.**
- **Any cancellation/withdrawal of admissions after the closure of admission process, the candidate shall forfeit the entire fees (Except the caution deposits) in addition, the candidate has to pay Rs. 5000/- as processing fee.**
- The candidate who secures a seat, should submit the certificates **in Original along with the prescribed fees** at the time of counselling itself.
- During the counselling process, the seat availability position will be updated at the end of the day and hosted on the University's website: [www.pjtsau.edu.in](http://www.pjtsau.edu.in). **The candidates are requested to go through the above information hosted on the website and accordingly attend the counselling. No separate communication will be sent in this regard.**
- **The University does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.**

- The applicant is informed that mere submission of an online application and attending for counselling do not guarantee the allotment of seat.
- **Candidates are required to read the PROSPECTUS thoroughly before applying.**
- In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University will take appropriate action against the individuals concerned.
- The parents and candidates should regularly visit the University website [www.pjtsau.edu.in](http://www.pjtsau.edu.in) for any further information.
- Professor Jayashankar Telangana Agricultural University (PJTAU) is the only Agricultural University in the State.
- Registrars of the respective Universities are responsible for the information furnished in the prospectus related to their courses.

- All the SPECIAL quota seats will be filled through the combined counselling only.
- In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University **will take appropriate action** against the individuals concerned and his/her application will be summarily rejected.
