Sub: Raj Bhavan, Telangana – Conduct of contest for State University students on 1. Essay writing, 2. Elocution and 3. G20 Logo making as part of creation of awareness about India's Presidency of G20 – Details communicated–Request for conduct of contest- Regarding.

I am directed to inform you that the Hon'ble Governor and Chancellor wishes to hold contests for State University students as part of raising awareness among university students about India's G20 presidency and providing a platform for university students to project their innovative, exciting, and novel ideas and imaginative skills on India's role as G20 Presidency. The Hon'ble Governor will distribute the prizes to the winners, and all the participants will be given participation certificates. The details of the contest are as follows:

There will be (3) competitions namely

1. Essay writing
2. Elocution
3. Making the G20 logo

2. For 1st and 2nd competitions, the contests will be in four languages, i.e., 1. Telugu, 2. Hindi, 3. English, and 4. Urdu, and the topic for both elocution & essay competition will be:

"One Earth, One Family, One Future (Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam)"—the vision of India's G20 Presidency.

3. Depending on the demand and students availability, the universities may decide to restrict the number of languages offered.

4. The third competition will involve creating the G20 logo in any form, such as sculpture, painting, or any other mode. The JNAFAU will be the sole organiser of this competition, and it will invite nominations from students from all state universities. It will decide the modalities of the contest in consultation with the Raj Bhavan.

5. These competitions will be held on two levels, i.e., preliminary level and final level.

Preliminary level: The universities will give wide publicity and invite names for participation in the contests in the given format, and they will conduct the contests and finalise the best five contestants in each category, like "essay in English," "essay in Telugu," "essay in Hindi," "essay in Urdu," etc., and so on and send their names and details to Raj Bhavan.

Final Contest: The Raj Bhavan, in collaboration with TSCHE, will hold a state-level competition for contestants who emerged as winners in the preliminary level, as communicated by the vice chancellors, and basing on the performance in final contests, the first, second, and third prizes and the three consolation prize winners in each category will be determined.

6. The Hon'ble Governor will felicitate and distribute prizes to the winners in a special function at Raj Bhavan

7. I am directed to request you to conduct these contests at your university level within the time frame stipulated and send a final list of a maximum of five students in each of the two categories i.e. 1) Essay writing 2) Elocution, language wise: , so as to enable Raj Bhavan to conduct state-level contests as stipulated in the brochure.

8. A nodal officer may please be nominated for each university to coordinate with the Raj Bhavan and the TS Council for Higher Education in this matter. The nodal officer of Raj Bhavan is Sri J.Bhavani Shankar, Joint Secretary to Governor, (mobile: 9246228700). Any further clarification in this regard can be had from the nodal officer, Raj Bhavan, Telangana.


9. You are further requested to ensure that the contests within your university are conducted in a foolproof manner as per the time schedule mentioned in the brochure and send the nominations of the five best performing students in each category to Raj Bhavan, Telangana, by December 31, 2022.

10. Further, you are requested to give wide publicity to these competitions among all the affiliated and constituent colleges by notifying on your university website and inviting applications from willing students. Further, it is requested to encourage more students to participate in the contest to make it a grand success.
