Guidelines for the PJTSAU – Best Research Scientist Award

- 1. Teachers in the cadre of Assistant Professors / Associate Professors will be eligible for the award.
- 2. Minimum of 5 years class room / laboratory teaching / research / extension experience is necessary to become eligible for the award.
- 3. Such of those who are working presently in research or extension or teaching but have put in 5 years of experience during the preceding seven years also be made eligible for particular award.
- 4. The total number of awards is **TWO**.
- 5. If suitable candidates are not available for consideration for any award in any faculty then those awards shall not be awarded that year.
- 6. Each award consists of **Rs. 10,000/-** in cash and a certificate Procedure for selection:
- 7. Application may be submitted by teachers / scientist / extension scientist in quadruplicate through proper channel. A committee of Associate Dean / ADR and two Senior Professor/Professor/Associate Professor may be constituted to screen the applications received for consideration for the award. The Committee shall prepare a merit list and forward them to the University along with their applications. The Associate Dean / ADR has to forward the bio-data of other applicants also to the University.
- 8. While short listing the candidates, the Associate Dean / Associate Director of Research shall critically examine the credentials of the teachers / scientist by making special efforts, both directly and discretely to find out how best the teacher, research scientist and extension scientist really is. They should also take into account the honesty and integrity and the confidential reports of the candidates for the reporting period.
- 9. The Vice-Chancellor may appoint a committee of Deans, Directors and External Experts to select the best teacher/scientist/extension scientist from the panels received from the respective Associate Deans / ADRs.
- 10. There should be at least 5 years of gap for the same award by the teacher / Research Scientist / Extension Scientist
- 11. The candidate should get minimum 60 per cent marks (average of five years) to apply for any award.
- 12. The University reserves the right of selection of applicants. There will be no appeal against it.
