- 3. The publications of First Author and Second Author only will be considered for the award.
- 4. The candidate must submit the copies of research papers published with NAAS rating.
- 5. The published article must have been updated on staff database.
- 6. The candidate must submit H Index particulars and ORCID ID no.

II. Teacher / Research Scientist / Extension Scientist with Highest

Funded External Project:

- 7. The award will be given to the Teacher/Research Scientist/Extension Scientist who was awarded the projects with highest funding as Principal Investigator and / or Co-Principal Investigator during the last three years preceding June.
- 8. Preference will be given to the projects sanctioned under competitive grants by funding agency.
- 9. The Scientist/faculty obtaining the projects under RKVY, Network, Paid-up trails of private agencies etc., will not be considered for the award.
- 10. The candidate must submit H Index particulars and ORCID ID no.
