RULES GOVERNING THE AWARD OF "Dr. B. NAGARAJA RAO GOLD MEDAL"

- 1. The endowment shall be called as "Dr. B. Nagaraja Rao Gold Medal Fund"
- 2. Gold Medal shall be called as "Dr. B. Nagaraja Rao Gold Medal"
- 3. The endowment amount of Rs.1.00 lakh shall be kept in two separate Fixed Deposits of Rs.50.000/- each in the name of Comptroller, Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University, Hyderabad and operated by him as detailed below:
 - a. 50 % of the endowment (i.e Rs.50.000/-) may be invested in Fixed Deposit to earn annual interest for preparing Gold medal every year and this Deposit shall be called as Fixed Deposit 1
 - b. Remaining 50 % of the endowment (Rs.50.000/-) may be invested in another Fixed Deposit with cumulative option (to reinvest the interest in the capital) to meet the future escalation charges of Gold etc., and this Deposit shall be called as Fixed Deposit -2
- 4. The endowment fund shall be administrated by the Registrar, Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University, Hyderabad, hereafter called as "The Administration".
- 5. The Gold Medal shall be awarded to the Best worker in **Pulses Research**, who has to be chosen through a Selection Committee constituted for this purpose and shall be presented during the Foundation day of the University.
- 6. He/ She should get minimum 60 per cent marks (average of five years) to be considered for the award.
- 7. The University shall have the discretion not to award the medal in any year, if in its opinion, none is found suitable for the medal
- 8. In the event of the medal not being awarded in any year, the unspent interest shall be added to the corpus fund.
- 9. The Vice-Chancellor, Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University, shall have the power consistent with the intention of the Donor to make such change(s) in the conditions governing the Award, as the circumstances may render necessary from time to time.
