## RULES GOVERNING 'JANNAREDDY VENKAT REDDY PRIZE' FOR OUTSTANDING AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH WORK DONE IN TELANGANA STATE

1	NAME OF THE PRIZE	:	JANNA REDDY VENKAT REDDY
2	DONOR OF THE PRIZE	:	The prize shall be awarded out of the interest Accrued of the combined Endowment amount of <b>Rs.47,000/-</b> ( <b>Rupees Forty seven thousand only</b> ) (JANNAREDDY VENKATREDDY Prize and Memorial lecture) donated by the Farmers Welfare Trust, Hyderabad for each on <b>every Alternate year</b> .
3	NATURE OF THE PRIZE	:	The prize shall be in the form of a Gold Medal and Cash of a total value of <b>Rs.6,000/-(Rupees Six</b> <b>thousand only)</b> . Explanation: if the amount of interest Accruing on the Endowment is different from the amount mentioned above, roughly the available amount may be awarded.
4	PURPOSE OF THE PRIZE	:	To create incentive for high quality Fundamental or applied research and to encourage Originality of thought, experimentation, precision and sense of priority in the choice of topics for Research. The prize shall be awarded to any Agricultural Scientist working in Telangana State for most outstanding Research contribution to Agricultural production and more particularly in the area of Crop Breeding, Management and Protection. It shall be awarded once in two years.
5	ADMINISTRATION OF THE PRIZE	:	The Vice Chancellor of PJTSAU in consultation with the Farmers' Welfare Trust, Brindavan, 173, Fateh Maiden North Road, Hyderabad-4 shall administer the award. He may debit all incidental costs of administering the Endowment to the said amount. When it shall become necessary to make any changes in the Rules, the Vice Chancellor of PJTSAU shall have the right to make such changes as may be necessary. The PJTSAU shall have the right to award the prize and manage the Endowment.

6	ELIGIBILITY OF THE PRIZE	:	All Agricultural Scientists working in Telangana State shall be eligible for the prize. The prize shall be awarded for notable and Original research contribution to agricultural production and work done by the scientist in the previous 5 years period provided that the Award shall not be made to the same person twice consequently or more than twice to the same person.
7	JUDGING COMMITTEE	:	Candidates shall be judged on the basic of the research achieved / contributions made by them. There shall be a panel of atleast three eminent scientists to decide the names of the recipient of the prize. The Head of the ICAR Institute and Vice- Chancellor, PJTSAU shall each nominate a Scientist any vacancy caused in the panel shall be filled from the nominator concerned.
8	PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION	:	The Registrar of PJTSAU shall announce through a circular letter to the Heads of all Institutions and Organizations engaged in Agricultural Research in the area inviting applications from and / or nominations or sponsor of the scientists or request for bio-data of the scientists for the award. The PJTSAU shall contact the applying of nominated of sponsored scientist to send the bio-data to get his work evaluated. The Scientists of those making nominations shall send in the bio-data of the concerned scientists and the paper concerning the
			concerned scientists and the paper concerning the Research work in quadruplicate indicating precisely and in concise terms the work that has been done and the bearing it has on agricultural production. After the last date for receipt of the application is over, the Registrar shall consult the judges, if necessary. After the preliminary screening is completed when it has become necessary, the application finally selected for evaluation will be circulated to the judges.

9	PRESENTATION OF THE PRIZE	:	Each member of the panel of judges shall be then make known to the University by the date specified by the University his choice for the award of the prize. He shall record his reasons for the choice and also mention the work of the candidates for which the award is recommended. If no two judges agree on a common name, the opinions of the Judges together with the relevant records, shall be re-circulated to all of them for reconsideration. Whenever practicable a meeting of all the judges may be requested. If even after reconsideration, the differences persist, all the opinions and minutes of the judges shall be sent to the

			The prize with a Citation shall be awarded in the Foundation Day of the University in every alternate year.
