Guidelines of the Awards for PJTSAU Best Research Paper with highest NAAS rating & Best Teacher / Research Scientist / Extension Scientist with Highest Funded External Project

- It is proposed by the University to give the above two awards in the University Foundation Day.
- The objective is to provide recognition to the outstanding Teacher/Research Scientist / Extension Scientist and promote quality and excellence in Teaching/Research/Extension.
- The awards consists of cash prize of Rs.10,000/-, Certificate and a Memento (each)

The awards proposed for:

I. "Best research Paper with Highest NAAS rating"

- 1. The award will be given to the Teacher/Research Scientist/Extension Scientist who has published his/her research findings in standard national or international journals with highest NAAS rating during the last two years preceding May, 2024.
- 2. The research work must have been carried out by staff and or research work of the student of PJTSAU.
- 3. To be eligible for this award, the applicant must have published her/her research paper with NAAS rating of >7 and above.

4. The publications of First Author and Second Author only will be Considered for the award.

- 5. The candidate must submit the copies of research papers published with NAAS rating.
- 6. The published article must have been uploaded on staff data base only will be considered.
- 7. The University reserves the right to select or not any of the applicants for the award.

II. Teacher / Research Scientist / Extension Scientist with Highest Funded External Project :

- 1. The award will be given to the Teacher/Research Scientist/Extension Scientist, who was awarded the projects with highest funding as Principal Investigator and / or Co-Principal Investigator during the last three years preceding May of every year.
- 2. The fund sanction orders should contain clear allocation of funds among the PI and Co-PI of the project. The word Co-PI will applicable to those projects which are multi-institutional funded projects.
- 3. The project/projects once claimed for the award shall not be eligible to claim for the same award in the succeeding years.
- 4. Preference will be given to the projects sanctioned under competitive grants by funding agency.
- 5. The Scientist/faculty obtaining the projects under RKVY, Network, Paid-up trails of private agencies etc., will not be considered for the award.
- 6. The University reserves the right to select or not any of the applicants for the award.
