1. Preamble

The ASPIRE scheme of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Government of India aims to support the establishment of Livelihoods Business Incubation (LBI) centers. These centers are intended to foster entrepreneurship and promote startups in the agro-industry. The scheme focuses on various goals, including job creation, reducing unemployment, promoting an entrepreneurial culture, and facilitating grassroots economic development at the district level by setting up LBIs. 13. Price Offer

- a) The Financial bid should be kept only in the Part II cover.
- b) The Financial bid should be prepared as per Annexure-IX.
- c) The price should be neatly and legibly written both in figures and words.
- d) In case of discrepancy between the prices quoted in words and figures lower of the two shall be considered.
- e) If a bidder quotes NIL charges/consideration, the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered.
- f) Part-II (Financial Bid) should not contain any commercial conditions. Variation in the commercial terms and conditions of the tender will not be accepted.

14. Evaluation of the Price

- a) The Tender committee will examine for complete, properly signed and error-free nature of the Financial Bid (Part II).
- b) The comparison of the rates offered shall be based on the total all-inclusive rates offered

15. Award of Contract

- a) The Tenderer who has quoted lowest price (L1) will be issued the 'Letter of Acceptance' by the Implementing Agency.
- In unavoidable circumstances, such as receipt of very limited bids or the proposal prices are substantially higher than the market value / updated cost estimate or available budget, the committee may decide upon resorting to Negotiation with the lowest evaluated responsive bidder. In such cases, the Tenderer who has quoted lowest price (L1) will be invited for negotiations and after finalizing the negotiated rate, Letter of Acceptance will be issued.

16. Security Deposit

- a) On receipt of the Letter of Acceptance from IA, the successful tenderer should remit a Security Deposit (SD) of 2% of the value of the contract in the form of Account payee Demand Draft from any Specialized Institutional Banking Branch or irrevocable Bank Guarantee with a validity period of one year in favour of "Office Comptroller, PJTAU", before any claim for payment is entertained by the Tendering authority.
- b) The tenderer may also request the Tender Committee to deduct the 3% SD payable to "Comptroller, PJTAU", from the first payment due to the tenderer.
- Any other amount pending with IA will not be adjusted under any circumstances, against the Security Deposit if so requested.
 - a. If the Security Deposit amount is not paid within the time specified, the EMD remitted by the tenderer shall be forfeited, besides cancelling the communication of acceptance of the Tender.
- d) Security Deposit amount remitted will not earn any interest

17. Agreement

The successful tenderer should execute an agreement as may be drawn up to suit the conditions on a non-judicial stamp paper of value, within 10 days of declaration of result of tender and shall pay for all stamps and legal expenses incidental thereto. In the event of failure to execute the agreement, within the time prescribed, the EMD/SD amount remitted by the tenderer will be forfeited besides cancelling the Tender.

18. Issue of Purchase Order

After successful execution of the agreement and deposit of SD if applicable, Purchase Order will be released by the IA. The successful tenderer should complete the supply, erection and commissioning of machineries, equipment, and its accessories at the Common Facility Centre of LBI, Agricultural Research Station, Tandur within 15 days from the date of receipt of Purchase Order. The work is to be carried out on a LSTK basis covering all <u>fixtures tools</u>, <u>pipelines</u>, <u>water supply</u>, <u>equipment</u>, <u>electrical control panel</u>, <u>power boards</u>, <u>cables</u>, <u>switches etc. including minor civil works for installation and any other seen/unseen items that may be conditional requirement for installation & commissioning of the machineries.</u>

19. Schedule of Supply

- a) The specification of machineries, equipment and its accessories should be as per Annexure-I of the respective package. The supply, erection & commissioning and performance test of machineries, equipment and its accessories for the respective packages shall be completed within 15 days from the date of issue of purchase order. Delay beyond this period may attract penalty (0.5% PER WEEK) Delays beyond that period will be viewed as violation of the contract terms and will be dealt accordingly. The machineries, equipment and its accessories should be delivered and installed at the Livelihood Business Incubator, Tandur, District Vikarabad, Telangana.
- a) The supplier shall include manufacturer recommended list of spares (MRLS) & cost thereof for two years successful running of the machine in their quotation. There shall be no additional financial obligation on part of the implementing agency for any MRLS consumed during the 2

years. The IA in consultation with the TA will ascertain if the supplier has provisioned adequate number and quality of spares as part of the delivery.

- b) If the contract is not completed within the stipulated time or extended time, Tender Committee will hold full authority to cancel the tender or take any such action that will be deemed fit to the occasion at the risk and cost of the successful tenderer. Such cancellation will entail forfeiture of EMD and Security Deposit.
- c) In the event of non- performance of the contractual provisions or failure to effect the supply, erection & commissioning and performance test within the stipulated time or during the extended period and if it is found that the supplier, has not fulfilled the contractual obligation with IA in any manner during the currency of the contract or also found on later date, Tender Committee reserves the right to disqualify such supplier to participate in future tenders or black list the firm up to a maximum period of 3 years.
- d) Every step will be taken by the IA to make infrastructure ready at the scheduled time of dispatch of Machinery, equipment, and its accessories. If there is any delay due to any reason on the part of the IA, release of payment will be considered based on delivery schedule given in Purchase Order.

20. Performance Test

- a) The successful tenderer shall demonstrate the performance of the machineries, equipment, and its accessories in complete conformity with the relevant technical specifications and performance parameters as specified in the Purchase Order.
- b) This demonstration should be done as stipulated by the IA in the presence of the TA.
- The performance tests should be completed within 30 days from the date of delivery of machineries, equipment, and all accessories. However, the period of supply, erection, commissioning, and performance test should not exceed the period stipulated in the purchase order.
- d) The supplier shall support to the best of their ability support and be responsible for the statutory licenses and clearances required by the cluster farmers to begin commercial production from the unit. Bidders are encouraged to visit the location before bidding to ascertain current road conditions, location conditions and considerations.

21. Training of Staff

- a) The successful tenderer should provide training to Staffs on the operation and maintenance of the machineries, equipment, and its accessories after completion of the performance test.
- b) The successful tenderer should provide 2 hard copies and soft copies of operation manuals for the machineries, equipment, and its accessories to IA.
- c) Provision of appropriate metallic signage on machinery pertaining to safety measures, hazards, and other relevant information for appropriate maintenance of supplied machinery and equipment.

22. Performance Guarantee

- a) The machineries, equipment and its accessories are to be guaranteed for a period of 12 months from the date of completion of performance test against manufacturing defect, bad workman ship or poor performance.
- b) During performance guarantee period of 12 months the successful tenderer should attend any call from IA immediately, in case of any problems, related to operation or malfunctioning of the machinery, equipment & accessories, without any delay for regular operation of the machinery. The above service should be done at Free of cost.
- After completion of one year performance guarantee period successfully, the SD security deposit furnished by the tenderer or SD retained by the IA, will be returned to tenderer, after recovery of dues if any.

23. Payment terms

100% payment will be done after 100% delivery of machineries at our site.

24. Penalty

Failure to execute the entire contract within 15 days from the date of issue of work order will attract a penalty of 1% per 15 days (0.5% per week), on the full value of the contract up to a maximum of 10%. Delays beyond that period will be viewed as violation of the contract terms and will be dealt accordingly.

- The response time for attending the complaint raised by Nodal Agency has to be within 48 hours and resolution time for the same has to be within the next 48 hours. Failure to comply with the above timeline will attract a penalty of Rs.1000/- per day.
- b) Any delay on the part of IA should be intimated and sorted out immediately without affecting the progress of works.

25. Termination of Contract

IA in consultation with Working Committee reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time during the validity period on account of non-fulfilment of contract or for any of the reasons.

26. General Conditions

- a) Conditional tender in any form will not be accepted.
- b) Any notice regarding any matters, to the contractor shall deemed to be sufficiently served, if given in writing to his usual or last known place of business.
- d) Tender committee reserves the right to relax or waive or amend any of the tender conditions.
- d) The successful tenderer shall not outsource/off load either full or part of the work to any other agency / individual.
- e) If the performance of the tenderer is not as per the schedule, then tender committee reserves the right to cancel / reallocate full or part of the contract, at any stage of the contract execution.
- f) All items shall be verified at site for quality and quantity by designated representative(s) of the IA in consultation with the TA at the Common Facility Centre upon delivery.

27. Arbitration

a) In case of any dispute in the tender, including interpretation, if any, on the clauses of the tender or the agreement to be executed, the matter shall be referred by IA / Tenderer to an Arbitrator to be appointed by the Parties hereto by mutual agreement. If no such Arbitrator could be

appointed by mutual consent, the matter may then be referred to the (TA) AgHub Foundation,

for nominating an Arbitrator, the Arbitration proceedings being governed by the Arbitration

and Conciliation (Amendment) Act 2015.

b) The venue of the Arbitration shall be at the (TA) AgHub Foundation. The decision of the

Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties to the Arbitration.

c) The Arbitrator may with the mutual consent of the parties, extend the time for making the award.

The award to be passed by the Arbitrator is enforceable in the court at Nagaland.

28. Jurisdiction of the Court

Any dispute arising out of non-fulfilment of any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement or any

other dispute arising out of the arbitration award will be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts in the

City of Hyderabad only.
